## **REGISTRATION POLICY**

- 1. <u>Registration</u>: Members of the International Soccer Club can register a player with the Club online through the Club web-site: www.isoccerclubmississauga.com or by signing and completing a hard copy registration form which can be given to Club staff located at any field or facility or by delivery to the Club at its registered office.
- 2. <u>Registration/ Program Fees</u>: Program Fees and/ or Player Registration Fees are advertised and posted annually in advance of any program and may be paid by cheque or by a major credit card. No cash payments are permitted.
- 3. <u>NSF Charges</u>: If any cheques are returned by the Bank or are otherwise dishonoured, the Club charges an NSF Fee of \$35.00.
- 4. <u>Early Bird Price</u>: The International Soccer Club offers an early bird price until one (1) month prior to the commencement of any Program.
- 5. <u>Family Discounts</u>: The International Soccer Club offers the following family discounts:
  - 1-2 Players No Discount
  - 3 Players 15% Discount per player
  - 4 Players or more 20% Discount per player
- 6. <u>Referral Discount</u>: The Club offers a \$5 Discount for each player that registers with the Club as a result of a member referral. Any referrals MUST be validated in writing in advance of the player registration
- 7. <u>Waiting List</u>: If there are no positions available in the applicable House League Division, the player's name shall be put on the Club's Waiting List. If any player positions become available for any reason, players shall be contacted by the Club by order of registration and assigned to a team. The registration fees for waiting list players shall be prorated based on the number of remaining games after the player has been assigned to a team.
- 8. <u>Ontario Soccer</u>: All players, coaches, managers, Club directors, or match officials who register with the International Soccer Club are registered with Ontario Soccer through its third party IT service provider, SportsEngine, on a registration system platform called Oscar.
- 9. <u>Player Profile</u>: Registration information that is provided to SportsEngine in the Oscar registration system may be accessed and updated directly by each registrant.
- 10. <u>OSA Insurance</u>: Players, Coaches, Managers, other Team Officials and Match Officials must be registered with Ontario Soccer on the Oscar registration system to be insured by Ontario Soccer's insurer in connection with any potential personal injury that may occur when participating in any sanctioned soccer activity.
