COLLECTION POLICY

Outstanding Fees

- 1. A player will **not** be registered until their fees are current or paid. A player may not participate in games or training until fee payments are current.
- 2. If a member is on a payment plan and fails to make payments or stops completing payments, they will be contacted by the club. Failure to communicate with the club to find a solution and ensure that all fees are paid in a timely manner first result in the suspension from the program (first 14 days). Should the player not contact the club or complete payment after 14 days, the player will be removed from the program. Should the removal from the program result in additional fees or fines, these will be incurred by the player.
- 3. International Soccer Club registers its members in good standing as a player with its governing bodies (Peel Halton Soccer Club and Ontario Soccer).
- 4. A player will **not** be registered if outstanding fines or fees have not been paid. 5. All returned cheques are subject to a \$50 NSF fee.

Discounts

The International Soccer Club offers the following family discounts:

- 1-2 Players No Discount
- 3 Players 15% Discount per player
- 4 Players or more 20% Discount per player

Registration

Should a program fill, ISC will offer a waitlist for the program at no charge to the member. Should a spot become available, it will be filled on a first come, first serve basis based on the waitlist.

Releases/Transfers

A release or transfer will not be honoured for a competitive player until ALL outstanding fees/fines have been paid in full. The Player card will be held by the club until all outstanding fees/fines are paid.

Fines – Players, Coaches, Teams

Fines incurred by players, coaches, and/or teams, must be paid to ISC within 14 days of the fine being issued. International SC will not be responsible for league, tournament, and provincial fines received by players, coaches, and teams. Should a fine not be paid within 14 days of being received, the player will be suspended at their cost.
